

Stewardship Update: Suspend® PolyZone®

We have received a few inquiries regarding which Suspend® PolyZone® label directions should be followed, as the label found on product packaging differs from the label posted on the Pesticides Regulatory Directorate (PRD, formerly the Pest Management Regulatory Agency, or PMRA) website. At this time, customers should follow the label currently posted on the PRD website, as this is the officially approved label in Canada.

For background, Envu™ supported an emergency use request in 2024 for box tree moth at the request of the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture after DeltaGard® SC insecticide was no longer commercially available. We were subsequently informed that this use would become a full registration in 2025. When the updated registration was issued, significant formatting changes were made to other sections of the product label that were unrelated to box tree moth. These changes were implemented without prior consultation with Envu and included revisions to the turf and surrounding vegetation directions for use.

Since becoming aware of these changes, Envu has been actively engaged with PMRA to address our concerns. We have met with PRD, submitted detailed feedback, reviewed and provided input on draft amendments that they have shared, and continue to work collaboratively toward a resolution. We remain optimistic that the issues will be addressed and that an amended label reflecting practical use patterns and supporting data can be finalized in the near future.
