#### **Application details:**

- Application rate: 2.2 to 3.4 L/ac.
- For best results, apply to actively growing weeds at the 2
  to 4 leaf stage. Treat wheat, oats and barley from the time
  the crop is in the 3-leaf expanded stage to the
  early flag leaf (shot blade) stage. Safe to apply on
  seedling and established grasses. Do not apply to grain
  under-seeded to legumes.
- Avoid applying in very hot weather or drought conditions.
- Rainfall within 4 to 6 hours may reduce effectiveness. Do not water grasses for 24 hours after application, and do not cut grass for 3 to 4 days before or after application.
